LOCAL LAW 3 of 2003 CURFEW AMENDMENT

Section 2: Responsibility of Parent or Guardian – No parent, guardian, or any other person having the legal care, custody, or control of any child under the age of eighteen (18) years shall knowingly allow or permit such child to go or be in or upon any of the places referred to in Section 1 of this law in the Town of Brant, New York, after time specified in said Section 1 unless there exists reasonable necessity therefor.

Section 3: Police to Enforce – Any law enforcement official having jurisdiction in the town is authorized to detain any minor violating Section 1 of this law. However, no minor shall be placed in confinement until reasonable effort shall have been made to locate and verbally notify the parent, guardian, or legal custodian of such minor of such detainment, and that an opportunity be given to such parent, guardian, or legal custodian to appear and obtain custody of such minor.
