TOWN OF BRANT LOCAL LAW No. 1-2018 ADOPTED FEBRUARY 13, 2018

A Local Law Extending the Eligibility Period for the Cold War Veterans Exemption under Town of Brant Local Law No. 1 of 2009

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRANT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Pursuant to recent amendments to Section 458-b of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the Cold War Veterans Exemption authorized by the Town of Brant Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2009 shall apply to qualifying owners of qualifying real property for as long as they remain qualifying owners without regard to the ten (10) year limitation set forth in the original authorizing provisions of Section 458-b of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.
- 2. This law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of the State as provided in Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
