It is hereby resolved by the Town of Brant; Erie County, State of New York that:

**DOG LICENSING FEES**  
**RESOLUTION # 356**

**WHEREAS**, The State of New York, Department of Agriculture, as of January 1, 2011 has transferred dog licensing to the local Government level, while maintaining the original three dollar spay and neuter fee, now called a spay/neuter surcharge, have given Local Governments the full responsibility of licensing dogs,

**WHEREAS**, The Brant Town Board chooses to maintain the current \$5.00 licensing fees for altered dogs, which includes the new one dollar spay/neuter surcharge as mandated by New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets.

**WHEREAS**, The Brant Town Board chooses to maintain the current \$13.00 licensing fees for intact dogs, which includes the State mandated three dollar spay/neuter surcharge mandated by the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets.

**WHEREAS**, The Brant Town Board chooses to maintain the current Purebred License fees of \$25 for 1-10 dogs plus \$3.00 per intact dog over 6 months of age, and \$50.00 for 11-25 dogs plus \$3.00 per intact dog over 6 months of age, and \$100 for more than 25 dogs plus \$3.00 per intact dog plus \$3.00 per intact dog over 6 months of age

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, The Town of Brant Town Board adopts the dog licensing fees as contained in this Resolution # 356, this 14<sup>th</sup> day of December 2010 to be effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 according to Part T of Article 59 of the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets.
