It is hereby resolved by the Town of Brant; Erie County, State of New York that:

**IMPOUND & KENNEL FEES  
RESOLUTION # 358**

**WHEREAS**, The State of New York, Department of Agriculture, Article 7 has previously permitted local Government's to charge owners of impounded dogs fees to cover the expense of dog control,

**WHEREAS**, Agriculture and Markets now requires all local governments to maintain or contract a municipal dog shelter to house impounded dogs.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, The Town of Brant Town Board hereby adopts the following dog impound and kennel fees:

\$25 for the first impound, \$35 for the second impound, and \$50.00 for the third impound, plus all impounds will be charged \$5.00 per day the dog remains in the kennel/shelter, and it is further

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED**, that owners of dogs treated by a veterinarian during impound, reimburse the Town for the cost of treatment prior to redeeming the dog.
